APRIL 21, 2009

THE MEETING OPENED WITH THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA. TIME: 7:30 P.M.

PRESENT AT ROLL CALL WERE CHAIRMAN FRANK PISKUR, VICE-CHAIRMAN LINDA MORRISON, AND DOUGLAS EDWARDS. THE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT, RICHARD KNECHTGES, WAS ALSO PRESENT REPORTING FOR THE FISCAL OFFICER, LINDA SPITZER, WHO WAS ABSENT.

THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 7, 2009 EATON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES PUBLIC HEARING WERE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. PISKUR MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE AND MORRISON SECONDED THE MOTION. THESE MINUTES WERE GIVEN TO THE TRUSTEES PRIOR TO THIS MEETING AND SO WERE NOT READ AT THE MEETING. THE MINUTES ARE ON FILE AT THE EATON TOWNSHIP TOWN HALL FOR PUBLIC READING.

PISKUR – YES MORRISON – YES EDWARDS- YES

THE MINUTES OF THE APRIL 7, 2009 EATON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING WERE APPROVED AS WRITTEN. PISKUR MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT AND MORRISON SECONDED THE MOTION. THESE MINUTES WERE GIVEN TO THE TRUSTEES PRIOR TO THIS MEETING AND SO WERE NOT READ AT THE MEETING. THESE MINUTES ARE ON FILE AT THE EATON TOWNSHIP TOWN HALL FOR PUBLIC READING.

PISKUR- YES MORRISON – YES EDWARDS- YES

BILLS TOTTALLING \$36,384.13 WERE APPROVED FOR PAYMENT. PISKUR MADE THE MOTION TO APPROVE THE PAYMENT AND EDWARDS SECONDED THE MOTION.

PISKUR – YES EDWARDS- YES MORRISON – YES

IN REGARD TO THE 1<sup>ST</sup> INSTALLMENT OF THE LORAIN COUNTY SOLID WASTE GRANT, MORRISON MOVED TO ACCEPT THE AMOUNT OF \$13880.40 IN FUND NUMBER 2901 AND EDWARDS SECONDED THE MOTION.

MORRISON –YES EDWARDS – YES PISKUR – YES

PISKUR THEN READ THE PUBLIC COMMENT REGARDING INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE SIGNED IN AND WOULD LIKE TO ADDRESS THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES WITH PUBLIC COMMENTS. THEY ARE REQUESTED TO KEEP THEIR COMMENTS LIMITED TO THREE (3) MINUTES.

BEFORE THE PUBLIC COMMENTS, THOMAS WELSH OF OTARMA SPOKE. THIS IS IN REGARD TO OTARMA RENEWAL EFFECTIVE 05/01/2009 TO 05/01/2010. MR. WELSH SAID TO REVISIT THE VEHICLE VALUES, MISCELLANEOUS PROPERTY VALUES AND ELECTRONIC DATA PROCESSING EQUIPMENT VALUES. THE FORMS NEED TO BE SIGNED APPROVING THE VALUES OR BY MAKING ANY CHANGES. MORRISON HAD QUESTIONS WHICH MR. WELSH WILL RESEARCH FOR ANSWERS. THE PACKAGE CONTRIBUTION TOTAL IS \$17,774.00, LESS C.D.L. CREDIT OF \$25.00, NO MVR CREDIT, OTARMA VIP CREDIT OF \$3392.00 AND A BUDGET RELIEF CREDIT FOR 2009 OF \$1696.00, LEAVING AN INVOICE BALANCE OF \$12,661.00 TO BE PAID TO OTARMA.

**PERSONS WHO SIGNED IN TO SPEAK AT THIS EATON TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES MEETING**

CAROL CROWELL OF 110 COUNTRY PLACE—WANTED TO KNOW IF THE TRUSTEES ARE GOING TO SUPPORT EATON TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS AGAINST LORCO. MORRISON THEN SAID A MOTION WAS MADE AT THE APRIL 7, 2009 TRUSTEES MEETING FOR THE LORAIN COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE TO CONTACT THE PROSECUTOR FROM SYLVANIA TOWNSHIP TO SEE IF IT IS FEASIBLE TO STOP LORCO. A SENIOR STAFF LAWYER FROM SYLVANIA TOWNSHIP HAS BEEN CONTACTED BY JERRY INNES, LORAIN COUNTY PROSECUTOR, AND THE LAWYER WAS GOING TO DISCUSS THIS SITUATION WITH HIS CHIEF AND GET BACK TO US. PER MORRISON, WE ARE WAITING FOR A RESPONSE FROM LUCAS COUNTY. MORRISON HAS INDICATED THAT WE ARE ENTITLED TO HAVE REPRESENTATION AND IF OUR LORAIN COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE CANNOT REPRESENT EATON TOWNSHIP THEN THEY NEED TO FIND A COUNTY THAT WILL REPRESENT OUR TOWNSHIP. HURON, ERIE AND MEDINA COUNTIES HAVE BEEN CONTACTED SO FAR AND THEY INDICATE THEY ARE SHORT OF FUNDS AND THEY ARE HAVING TROUBLE KEEPING UP WITH THEIR OWN WORK. IF LUCAS COUNTY WOULD REPRESENT US THEY WOULD ONLY ASK FOR OUT OF POCKET MONEY SUCH AS MILEAGE TO HERE AND SHE THINKS OUR TOWNSHIP CAN AFFORD THAT. IF LUCAS COUNTY CANNOT DO THAT SHE WILL GET PERMISSION FROM OUR TOWNSHIP TO HAVE THE LORAIN COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE TO CONTACT EVERY COUNTY IN OHIO TO FIND SOMEONE TO REPRESENT EATON TOWNSHIP. PER PISKUR, SYLVANIA TOWNSHIP WANTED A SEWER AND AFTER THEY REVISITED IT THEY DECIDED IT WAS NOT A GOOD DECISION AND THEY ABOLISHED IT. TO ANSWER YOUR QUESTION, PER PISKUR, WE ALL SUPPORT THE RESIDENTS OF THE TOWNSHIP WE HAVE BEEN TOLD BY LEGAL COUNSEL THAT WE CAN'T GET OUT OF LORCO. WE ARE LOOKING INTO THAT. IT IS STILL IN THE PROCESS-WE STILL HAVE NO ANSWERS AT THIS POINT IN TIME. IT IS STILL IN THE WORKS PER MORRISON, THE MOTION REFERRED TO ABOVE TO SEE IF IT IS FEASIBLE TO STOP LORCO—THE MOTION RECEIVED A NO FROM EDWARDS AT THE APRIL 7, 2009 MEETING. PER MS. CROWELL—SHE IS NOT SAYING WE DON'T NEED SEWERS BUT MAYBE NOT FROM LORCO. EDWARDS THEN WENT ON TO EXPLAIN COSTS INVOLVED.

JOE FISCHBACK OF 12187 EATON BLVD—MOVED TO EATON IN JANUARY 2009.— WANTS TO KNOW HOW MANY HOMES WILL BE BUILT—HAVE TO HAVE SOMETHING IN WRITING. PER MORRISON, THE PROJECTION IS 3700 HOMES IN THE FUTURE. PER PISKUR, HE BROUGHT UP THE LETTERS THAT WERE WRITTEN BY EDWARDS AND MCCORT TO THE USDA-RURAL DEVELOPMENT—EDWARDS BELIEVES IN THE CONCEPT BUT THE FEASIBILITY IS A QUESTION. THE LETTERS WERE CONCERNING THE MONTHLY COSTS TO THE RESIDENTS OF EATON TOWNSHIP.—EDWARDS SAID MORRISON WOULD NOT AND DID NOT WRITE A LETTER CONCERNING THE COSTS INVOLVED. HE SAID THERE WAS NO HELP WHATSOEVER REGARDING ASSISTANCE FROM THE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS. MR. FISCHBACK AGAIN REITERATED ON THE COST INVOLVED FOR THE SEWERS. MORRISON THEN COMMENTED THAT EDWARDS VOTED YES ON A LORCO RESOLUTION FOR RESIDENTS TO PAY \$42.500 A MONTH. THEN HE AND GARY MCCORT WROTE A LETTER TO COVER IT.

SHARON ESSEX OF 13190 AVON BELDEN ROAD—I CAN'T UNDERSTAND WHY THE THREE OF YOU ARE BICKERING AMOUNGST YOURSELVES. THE FINANCIAL BURDEN IS TOO MUCH AND SHE CAN'T AFFORD THIS PROJECT. SHE WANTS TO KEEP A ROOF OVER HER HEAD.

WAYNE ELKINS OF 12182 EATON BLVD.,--LIVED HERE FOR ABOUT 7 YEARS—THIS IS HIS FIRST TOWN HALL MEETING. IT HAS BEEN BROUGHT TO HIS ATTENTION THAT SOMEBODY WORKS FOR LORCO—PER PISKUR—NOBODY WORKS FOR LORCO. PER MORRISON, ONE TRUSTEE WAS APPOINTED TO REPRESENT US AT LORCO AND

THAT WAS MR. EDWARDS.

ELIZABETH RATTRAY OF 34595 DYE ROAD—LIVED IN EATON TOWNSHIP ABOUT A ONE AND ONE-HALF YEARS. SHE, TOO, CANNOT AFFORD ANY ADDITIONAL BURDENS ON HER BUDGET. HER CONCERN IS THAT THIS DECISION WAS MADE WITHOUT RESIDENTS INPUT. EVEN A MARRIAGE CAN BE DISSOLVED BY DIVORCE SO DON'T TELL US THAT WE CAN'T GET OUT OF LORCO. PER PISKUR, WE ARE WAITING FOR OPINION FROM THE LORAIN COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE. THEY ARE LOOKING INTO POSSIBILITY OF GETTING OUT OF LORCO. PER MS. RATTRAY, IT SEEMS LIKE YOU ARE SERVING US IN A CONFLICT OF INTEREST—HOW DO YOU SIT ON A BOARD OVER HERE AND REPRESENT THE PEOPLE OVER HERE ON THIS BOARD. YOU CAN'T SERVE TWO MASTERS. TO EDWARDS, ARE YOU BEING COMPENSATED FOR YOUR SERVICE TO THE LORCO BOARD—ABSOLUTELY NOT, PER EDWARDS.

JOHN O'CONNELL OF 33907 CAPEL ROAD—SPOKE ON REVISING OUR AMENDMENT—LINDA MADE MOTION TO GET OUT OF LORCO—IT DIED FOR LACK OF A SECOND—MR. O'CONNELL WENT ON TO SAY THAT WHEN LINDA WAS RUNNING FOR TRUSTEE SHE WENT AROUND FROM HOUSE TO HOUSE AND SAID SHE WOULD BE ON THE RESIDENTS SIDE—THE OTHER TWO TRUSTEES WOULD NOT SECOND THE MOTION TO GET OUT OF LORCO.—THE PROSECUTOR SAID THERE WAS A WAY HE COULD DO IT—YOU STILL WOULDN'T SECOND IT—PER PIKSUR—WE HAVE THE PROSECUTOR LOOKING INTO THIS.—WE HAVE TO SEE IF WE CAN LEGALLY DO IT BEFORE WE CAN SECOND THE MOTION TO GET OUT OF IT. PER MR. O'CONNELL, YOU CAN'T START LEGALLY TO DO IT WITHOUT THE MOTION. HE ALSO MENTIONED THE LETTER THAT DOUG READ AT THE APRIL 7, 2009 MEETING—ALL THAT LETTER SAID WAS THAT YOU WERE CONCERNED ABOUT LOWERING THE MONTHLY PRICES—HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE THE BILL GO AWAY TO ZERO. THE LETTER WAS NOT TO GET OUT OF LORCO--WHY ARE YOU MAKING A BIG THING OUT OF IT.

JIM MILBRANDT OF 9990 ROOT ROAD—NOTHING TO DO WITH LORCO—HE LIVES IN THE TOWN OF EATON—TOOK HIS TRUCK IN FOR REPAIRS AND AS THEY TOOK THE WHEELS AND AS THE DEPUTY WAS DUSTING FOR FINGERPRINTS—HE SAID—WHAT IS LORCO?—PER MR. MILBRANDT—THEY WANT TO BUILD 3700 HOMES IN EATON—THE DEPUTY DROPPED HIS DUSTER. HE SAID THERE ARE 3 DEPUTIES IN THE COUNTY--HOW ARE THEY GOING TO DO IT—WE HAVE NO PROTECTION.—HIS CLOSING REMARK—HE LOST HIS WHEELS BUT IT WAS GETTING TIME TO ROTATE THEM ANYWAY.

HE DOESN'T CARE HOW THE PLANS ARE DRAWN UP—IT'S GOING TO BE OVER THE BUDGET. HE SAID THIS TOWNSHIP WILL LOOK LIKE A DISASTER AREA WHEN THIS PROJECT IS DONE—THERE IS NO PROVISION TO REPLACE TREES IN YOUR FRONT YARD AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN TAKEN DOWN. THEY WILL PUT THIS SEWER IN AT A 4 % FALL WHICH MEANS THAT THEY ARE CARRYING THE SEWAGE AT A MUCH QUICKER RATE AND THEY ARE HAVING TO PUMP IT FARTHER BACK UP STREAM TO GET IT WHERE IT NEEDS TO GO. THIS IS WASTEFUL.THESE PLANS WERE THROWN TOGETHER AND IT LOOKS LIKE ALMOST OVERNIGHT. THEY QUESTIONED THE ENGINEER —WE GOT NO ANSWERS. TO THEM—THEY DON'T CARE. IT'S GONNA

WE ARE APPEALING TO YOU PEOPLE—PLEASE TRY TO GET OUT OF THIS. LINDA, GOD BLESS YOU.

DEBRA MILUM OF 37167 CAPEL ROAD—SHE WANTS TO SAY A COUPLE OF THINGS—IN THE LAST COUPLE OF MONTHS PEOPLE HAVE CALLED HER TO SEE THE VALUE OF THEIR RHOMES—IT IS SAD THAT SOME PEOPLE OWE MORE MONEY THAN THE HOME IS WORTH.—ONE INCIDENT THAT STICKS OUT—A GENTLEMAN DOWN THE STREET HAS WORKED FOR 23 YEARS—HE LOST HIS JOB—HIS WIFE—THEY CAN'T KEEP THEIR HOME WE ARE GOING TO BE LIKE CLEVELAND—WITH ALL THESE FORECLOSED HOMES SHE SHOWED HOMES ON SUNDAY—HOMES ARE BEING SOLD FOR LESS THAN WHAT THEY OWE ON THEM—NOW THEY ARE TRYING TO PUT MORE ON US. SHE SAID THAT RUSSELL REALTY SAID THIS IS A GOOD THING—IT WILL INCREASE THE VALUE OF THE HOMES. MRS. MILUM SAID SHE DOESN'T EVEN HAVE TO TIE IN WITH LORCO—THEIR HOME IS 300 FEET OFF THE ROAD AND THEY HAVE A NEW SEPTIC SYSTEM—THEY ARE IN IT FOR THE PEOPLE—NOT THE MONEY. SHE SAID HER HUSBAND LOST HIS PAY FOR 3 WEEKS AND IF HE DOESN'T STOP THIS HE WILL LOSE HIS JOB BECAUSE OF LORCO. A GUY FROM LORCO WENT TO HER HUSBAND'S UNION AND TOLD THEM YOU HAVE A RESIDENT WHO IS TRYING TO STOP CONSTRUCTION WORKERS FROM MAKING MONEY. WE HAVE TO STICK TOGETHER HERE—YOU CAN'T VOTE AGAINST THE PEOPLE—YOU HAVE TO HELP THEM.

JEFF MILUM OF 37167 CAPEL ROAD—APPRECIATES THE FACT THAT YOU OPENED UP THE FLOOR—THIS IS A BIG TURNOUT OF PEOPLE. ONE OF THE ISSUES THAT

CONCERNS HIM IS TOWNSHIPS IMPOSING SEWERS ON EATON TOWNSHIP WHEN THEY ARE NOT GETTING SEWERS. JIM MCCONNELL HAS SAID REPEATEDLY THAT THERE ARE NO PLANS TO EXTEND SEWERS IN ANY OTHER PART OF LORCO'S JURISDICTION. THIS IS A MATTER OF PRINCIPAL—DOUG AND FRANK—WHY IS ROCHESTER TOWNSHIP DICTATING TO US WITHOUT AT LEAST TRYING TO FIGHT. ROCHESTER, PITTSFIELD, PENFIELD---THEY ARE NOT GETTING SEWERS—WE ARE. WHO DO THEY THINK THEY ARE. LORCO'S INITIALLY STATED THEY WOULD BRING SEWERS TO THE ENTIRE DISTRICT—THEY ARE NOT DOING THAT. WE WERE NOT ASKED IF WE WERE IN FAVOR OF 3200 HOMES TO BE DEVELOPED. THESE DISCUSSIONS WERE APPARENTLY HELD IN PRIVATE OR SECRET—WE WERE NOT AWARE OF ANY OF THIS. ANOTHER POINT OF NOT BEING ON THE BUS—MR. MILUM BEGGED THE TRUSTEES FOR RESIDENTIAL MAILING OF WHAT IS GOING ON BUT THE TRUSTEES REFUSED TO DO THAT.—THIS IS DONE FOR DUMPSTER DAYS BUT IS NOT DONE TO KEEP THE RESIDENTS INFORMED OF HAPPENINGS WHICH AFFECTS THE LIVLIHOOD OF EVERYBODY IN THIS TOWNSHIP. THE RESIDENTS HAVE NO INPUT. OTHER TOWNSHIPS AND VILLAGES ARE DICTATING TO US—WE SHOULD RESIST THAT. THERE HAS REALLY BEEN NO EFFORT TO GET ANYBODY IN THIS TOWNSHIP INVOLVED AND/OR INFORMED. MR. MILUM ALSO MENTIONED FRED ALSPACH AND JIM MCCONNELL—PER MR. ALSPACH—PHASE II WILL START WHEN PHASE 1 IS SUBSTANTIALLY COMPLETE—MR. MCCONNELL SAID THERE ARE NO PLANS TO EXTEND SEWERS IN ANY PART OF LORCO—SOMEONE IS EITHER LYING OR VERY CONFUSED. 70% OF THIS PROJECT IS GOING TO SERVICE NEW HOMES IF THEY ARE BUILT. THAT IS NOT GOING TO HAPPEN —SEWERS ARE COMING IN FOR 30% OF THE PEOPLE.—THIS IS NOT FOR US—IT IS FOR THE DEVELOPERS. ANOTHER THING AND YOU SHOULD TAKE SOME ACTION ON THIS—BECKY HAYNES OF AVON LAKE MUNICIPAL UTILITIES HAS BEEN GOING AROUND DOOR TO DOOR AND MAKING PHONE CALLS TO GET PEOPLE TO SIGN EASEMENTS AND FROM WHAT HE GATHERS SOME OF THE LANGUAGE IS VERY INTIMIDATING.—THEY HAVE MENTIONED EMINENT DOMAIN AND SOME OTHER THINGS. IF SHE IS NOT AFFILIATED WITH LORCO--WHY IS SHE CALLING THE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS YOUR CONSTITUENTS, THE PEOPLE WHO PAY YOUR SALARY AND WHO YOU REPRESENT—SHE IS CALLING THEM. MR. MILUM THINKS YOU SHOULD BRING THIS TO A STOP. HE IS ASKING YOU TO LOOK INTO THAT. WE HAVE FILED A COMPLAINT—DONNA AND HIM—THIS IS DIRTY POOL—IF HE LOSES HIS JOB SO BE IT. PEOPLE DON'T WANT SEWERS AND YOU TRUSTEES NEED TO REPRESENT THE PEOPLE. THERE IS A COMET MEETING ON THE 30<sup>TH</sup> OF THIS MONTH AND HE WOULD LIKE TO SEE EVERYONE OF YOU THERE. WE COULD USE YOUR HELP AND ANY FINANCIAL HELP AS THEY WOULD LIKE TO RETAIN AN ATTORNEY.

JUDI TENNANT OF 109 ELBERT DRIVE—SHE AGREES WITH WHAT OTHER PEOPLE HAVE SAID—NAMED MR. DAMYANIC—WE WILL END UP LIKE NORTH RIDGEVILLE—IT IS ALL ABOUT PUTTING MONEY IN THEIR POCKETS.
