

Wayne Township Road Department Maintenance Year in Review 2008

Culvert Replacement

April 2 – Replaced Voice of America culvert
April 16 – Deleted culvert on Cotton Run Road near Withrow
April 22 – Replaced culvert at 5000 block of Cotton Run Road
April 23 – Replaced deep culverts at 5000 block of Cotton Run Road
May 5 – Replaced culvert at Van Trump and Roberts Road
July 15 – Replaced culvert on Mill Road near Stamper residence

Durapatching

We Durapatched for thirteen days starting on May 15 and completing on July 31.

Berming

We bermed Cotton Run Road from Taylor School Road to State Route 73.

Snow and Ice Events

There were nineteen snow and ice events with the first starting on January 1 and the last on December 23.

Mowing and trimming of Township cemetery and properties

We began mowing in April. We mowed the maintenance building fifteen times, the firehouse thirteen times, the land in Seven Mile eleven times and the cemeteries up to eleven times.

Roadside Mowing

We mowed for thirty days, starting May 7 and stopping October 2.

Paving and Chip Sealing

We contracted out paving of Cotton Run Road from Withrow Road to Tolbert Road. We contracted for chip sealing of Van Trump Road and the west end of Mill Road from Cotton Run Road to State Route 503.
