Regular meeting Minutes
May 19th, 2010, 8am

The Florence Township Trustees held their regular meeting on May 19th, 2010 at 8am. It was held at the Florence Township Office Complex located at 11011 Chapel St., Birmingham, Ohio. The following trustees were present:

The meeting was opened with the pledge.

MOTION: Orville made the motion and it was seconded by John to accept minutes from the May 5th meeting. Roll call: all 'ayes. Minutes approved.

Clerk reports she received a letter from the Erie Co. Commissioners'. They have withdrawn their Resolution of support for the Vermilion Scenic River Designation.

Clerk reports the township insurance policy may cover some of the expense to have the gutters replaced. She will submit the claim once she receives the needed paperwork.

Trustee Reports

Orville reports some work is being done on the mowers. They discussed purchasing a mower for the road side.

John states he has talked with the zoning inspector about TurboTron (Butler Rd.). He says Dave reports he is working on a letter to send to TurboTron with input from the Vermilion Prosecutor's office. It is unclear if the letter has been sent yet.

Trustees discuss a property on Stephens Rd. whose yard condition is creating a nuisance due to debris and rock; the noxious weeds cannot be mowed. Issue will be sent to Erie Co. Prosecutor's office for advisement.
