The Florence Township Trustees held their regular meeting on June 1st, 2011. It was held at the Florence Township Office Complex located at 11011 Chapel St., Birmingham, Ohio. The following trustees were present:

Clerk reports she will send certified letters to the two property owners on Second St. The township obtained easements on the properties in the early '90's. The Township will do some tile work to improve drainage in the area this summer. The letters will be to inform them of the work.

Clerk reports the cost of the township wide trash days is increasing considerably. This past bill was about \$6,000 for the two weekends this spring. There was about 36 tons of trash collected. Skip states the trustees should look into other options and maybe reduce or eliminate the service.
