The Florence Township Trustees held their regular meeting on June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 8am. It was held at the Florence Township Office Complex, located at 11011 Chapel St., Birmingham, Ohio. The following trustees were present:

**Old Business**

**Burr Rd.**

Work is underway on Burr Rd. to have the two "humps" removed near the Nash Rd. intersection.

**MOTION:** Skip makes the motion to have Precision Paving do the paving for the project. The quote is for \$30,000. The Motion is seconded by John. Roll call: all 'ayes. Motion approved.

**New Business**

Clerk reports she located a copy of the undeveloped section of the Birmingham Cemetery at the Erie Co. Engineers Office. It does have a layout for future lots. Tim will attempt to locate "pins" to see if it had indeed been pinned in the past.

Clerk reports receiving a letter from Erie Co. Solid Waste Management District. They are required to update their plan every five years. They are requesting Trustees discuss: subscription curbside recycling, non- subscription curbside recycling and continuation of Drop Off Recycling Locations and discuss the feasibility of each option. Trustees will request Lisa Beursken from the organization to explain and answers any questions at an upcoming Florence Township Meeting. Special Guest Bob England from The Erie County Health Dept. was here not to discuss that issue but did contribute some information on the budget restraints facing the Erie Co. Solid Waste Management District and the need to reorganize and review its services.

Mr. England was here to discuss HB 110 Household Sewage Treatment Systems (HTST). The bill revises regulations for the State. Contact him at the Erie County Health Dept. with any questions.

There was discussion on allowing the road crew work 4 ten hour days instead of the current 8 hour days for 5 days. Trustees could not see the benefit of this at this time.

**MOTION:** Skip makes the motion to accept the Erie County GSI Cost Share Agreement of \$1,193.93 annually. It is seconded by Orville. Roll call: all 'ayes. Motion passed.
