

**Florence Township Trustees
Regular Meeting Minutes
Aug. 18th 2010, 8am**

The Florence Township Trustees held their regular meeting on Aug. 18th, 2010 at 8am. It was held at the Florence Township Office Complex located at 11011 Chapel St., Birmingham, Ohio. The following trustees were present:

The meeting was opened with the pledge.

MOTION: Orville made the motion and it was seconded by Skip to approve the minutes from the 8-4-2010 meeting. Roll call: all 'ayes. Minutes approved.

Clerk reads a letter into record received from Mike Warholic, owner of TurboTron business on Butler Rd. The letter stated he has purchased a commercial building in Elyria, Ohio and will take possession in early September. He states there will be an increase of traffic and noise in the future due to this moving of the business.

Clerk reports Erie Co. Solid Waste Management has received at least 75% approval from county municipalities for their 15 year plan. They will meet for approval. Clerk reports Allied Waste is requesting a list of street addresses that fall within township boundaries to determine feasibility of drop off vs. curb side recycling. Clerk reports Erie Regional Planning and Engineers office do not have such records. Resident Dave Estes volunteers to work with the clerk in obtaining the information from other sources.

Clerk receives letter from Erie Co. Engineers office. They will charge \$4,180 to survey and "mark" the section of the Birmingham Cemetery that has not been opened at this point. Trustees state they would like to level out the ground and create roads before the survey work is done.

New Business

Clerk reports the Erie Co. Township Association's next meeting will be Sept. 9th at 7pm at the Oxford Township Town Hall.

Clerk reports original Fall Rubbish Days fell on Labor Day weekend. As a result- new dates will be Sept. 11th, 18th, and tire collection will be on Sept. 25th.

Clerk received a letter from Dan Styer of 9716 Dean Rd., Wakeman, Ohio. He states he has planted hundreds of oak and hickory trees on his property. He stated the property will be maintained as a forest, not a lawn, so there is no need to mow the area.

Clerk received three addresses that need to be mowed. The addresses are: 10409 Harrison, Wakeman; 10710 Burrows, Berlin Hgts.; and 5718 St. Rt. 60, Wakeman
