Application for Permit to Install a Driveway Culvert or Make Any Excavation in a Kingston Township Highway or Highway Right-Of-Way

Instructions:

Pursuant to Kingston Township Board of Trustees Resolution number 06-06-1, any person, before installing a driveway culvert or making any excavation in a Kingston Township highway or highway right-of-way within the jurisdiction of Kingston Township, except an excavation to repair, rehabilitate, or replace a pole already installed for the purpose of providing electric or telecommunications service, must first obtain a permit from Kingston Township for such installation of a driveway culvert or making any such excavation.

This requirement of a permit from Kingston Township is in addition to, and not in place of, obtaining a permit for such culvert installation and/or excavation as may be required by Delaware County, Ohio.

No application or fee shall be required for an excavation project to install five or fewer poles for the purpose of providing electric or telecommunications service, but the person making that excavation shall provide verifiable notice of the excavation to the Kingston Township Fiscal Officer at least three (3) business days prior to the date of the excavation.

The following requirements must be met in order to obtain a permit to install a driveway culvert or make any excavation in a Kingston Township highway or highway right-of-way:

1. An Application for Permit to Install a Driveway Culvert (**Form 06061-1**) or Make Any Excavation in a Kingston Township Highway or Highway Right-Of-Way (**Form 06061-2**) shall be completed and submitted to the Kingston Township Fiscal Officer at 7295 Blue Church Rd., Sunbury, Ohio 43074. Application forms can be obtained from the Township Zoning Office or Township Fiscal Officer.
2. **A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) shall be paid upon submission of each application.**
3. A separate application shall be completed and submitted for each culvert to be installed or for each excavation to be made.
4. The following shall be submitted with the application. Submission of the items listed below shall be a condition of granting the permit.
 - a. The applicant shall submit plans indicating the location, size, type, and duration of the culvert or excavation contemplated;
 - b. The applicant shall specify methods of excavation, refilling, and resurfacing to be followed that meet or exceed Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Construction and Material Specifications (CMS);
 - c. The applicant shall provide a statement that work zone traffic control devices and signage in accordance with the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices will be used;
 - d. Work zone traffic control devices and signage in accordance with the Uniform Manual of Traffic Control Devices shall be used;
 - e. The applicant shall, in a written statement, indemnify Kingston Township against liability and/or damage as the result of the installation of the culvert or as a result of the excavation; and,
 - f. The applicant, except an applicant installing a culvert beneath a driveway, shall post a deposit or bond, with sureties to the satisfaction of the Board, conditioned upon the performance of all conditions in the permit.
5. The applicant must contact Ohio Utilities Protection Service (OUPS) prior to any culvert installation or excavation and allow OUPS sufficient time to notify the applicant of any utilities that may interfere with the culvert installation or excavation.
6. **Kingston Township requires 30 working days to process this application.**
7. Following installation of the culvert or making of the excavation, Kingston Township reserves the right to inspect any culvert installed or excavation made to assure compliance with plans and specifications submitted with this Application and/or requirements made by Kingston Township as a condition of approving the permit. Kingston Township may require that any culvert installed or excavation made contrary to submitted plans and specifications or any additional requirements made by Kingston Township as a condition of granting a permit be corrected and made to conform to submitted plans and specifications or any additional requirements made as a condition of granting a permit.
