Roads

The township replaced a culvert on the northern leg of Blue Church Rd. The road repair and resurfacing work on Stockwell, Blayney, Rosecrans, and Wilson roads and Wildwood Lane is complete.

The township has purchased a new salt spreader and has committed to purchase salt in preparation for winter weather.

The Carter's Corner Road Bridge replacement project has finished ahead of schedule. The road should be open by the week of November 9. The project included replacement of the bridge with a new 36-foot span concrete slab bridge and approximately 800 feet of the roadway approaches were realigned to correct

a sharp curve at the bridge.

Zoning News

The Zoning Commission has reviewed and revised a large portion of the zoning code. They spent the last couple meetings reviewing edits of the document and will be continue to revise the remainder of the code.

The Zoning staff is following up on zoning complaints and violations and processing zoning permits.
