

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 10/2/07

All the officers were present for the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees. Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the minutes of the September 18 meeting were read and approved.

Tim Tyrone reported on the work he has done. Discussion was held on boxing in the pillars in the big hall that are getting scuffed by the chairs. Gordon made the motion, second by Conrad the work be done. Roll call, all yes. He gave the report on the various projects the Park Board has done and plan on doing.

Zoning Inspector Donahue handed out his written report.

Neil Crawford stated the basketball nets need replacing and was given permission to do so.

A new Cub Scout troop is starting up and permission was given to use the small conference room.

Trustee Gordon was thanked by Conrad and Younglas for all the work he has done toward beautifying the cemetery. He priced and brought back literature on gazebos and did the pricing on trees. He purchased 22 trees for the cemetery and then recruited volunteers to help him plant them. These included Gordon, Mr. and Mrs. Paul Eglin, Mr. and Mrs. David Thomas, Ron Irvan and Mr. and Mrs. William Albrecht. Albrecht asked for and received permission to purchase buckets that self water the trees.

Transfers were approved of \$550 from contingencies to other zoning; \$600 from contingencies to office supplies and \$3,000.00 from the General Fund to the Cemetery Fund.

Conrad reported on the Solid Waste meeting he attended about approving the proposed new plan. Younglas went to the B2C2 meeting and gave a report on that. It was stated that the Phase 1 of Sooy Road is almost completed.
