

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 10/03/06

All the officers and 9 guests were present for the regular Penfield Township Trustees meeting. The minutes of the September 19 meeting were approved with one clarification. Approval was given for contracts to two vendors, Crest for fence in both the park and cemetery and Cloudt for seeding/fertilizing/weed killing in both the cemetery and at the buildings.

Deputy Curtis stated that the persons doing the break-ins in the area have been apprehended. He handed out a written report on activity in the township during September.

Jean Eglin has ordered recycled giveaways from Solid Waste grant money. In the past, the Penfield 4th graders were taken to the George Jones organic farm for an educational tour from grant money. Since the schools have consolidated now it appears the entire 4th graders will have to be taken. Trustees agreed to fund any additional money the busing requires. Motion by Younglas, second by Conrad. Roll call, all yes.

Zoning Inspector Donahue handed out his monthly report. He attended the Building Inspector meeting and found it worth while.

Gordon has been leveling areas in the park that needed it.

Younglas commended Jean Eglin on the way she takes care of the flower beds and their appearance.

Conrad made the motion, second by Gordon the township follow the most of the county and hold trick or treat on October 31 from 6-7:30 P.M.

The millage set forth by the auditor was approved with resolution 10-3-06 on a motion by Younglas, second by Conrad. Roll call, all yes.

The checks, blanket certificates and purchase orders were approved as presented on a motion by Younglas, second by Conrad. Roll call, all yes.

Line transfers approved on a motion by Younglas, second by Conrad were: \$0.18 from 1000-930-930 contingencies to 1000-110-111- trustees salaries; \$500.00 from 2021-330-360-contracts to 2021-330-111 trustees salaries; \$1,000 from 1000-930-930 contingencies to

1000-110-330 travel. Motion carried.

Conrad reported that the seeding/weed killer and fertilizing has been done in both the park and cemetery. He stated that rolls of carpet and dry wall were dropped on the roadside.

Schettler is working on the plans for the garage addition.

The Country House Doctor was hired to repair any water leaks in the park on a motion by Conrad, second by Younglas. Roll call, all yes.

Bill Koubeck and Corey Rider attended the meeting as part of a school Government Class project .

With no further business, Conrad made the motion to adjourn second by Gordon.
