

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 10/17/06

All the officers and 9 guests were present for the regular meeting. An addition was that besides repairing the leaks, the Country House Doctor was to take care of drainage problems.

The Keystone Alumni Band was given permission to use the hall, rent free, for a Christmas Concert on December 2.

Zoning Inspector Donahue reported that a 2,600 sq. ft. business, Natures Garden, will be erected on the former Bara property on Tte.18. The area is zoned commercial. He gave a detailed report on what he feels the Township is due from the Cable Company. A legal opinion was rendered by the Prosecutor on the fact that the Building Department would have to hire someone to inspect the inside plumbing.

Recreation Board member, Duane Johnson stated that the swings have been painted and the faulty swing ordered. Rubber mulch has been placed in an area of the walking trail and he invited the trustees to see it and comment on it before they finish the placement.

Paul Eglin will be taken the discolored and shabby arrangements from the cemetery.

Jean Eglin said the school trip is canceled due to no response from the school, in spite of many phone calls. She is ordering cookies and punch for the band concert.

Earlier the quilters had donated pictures of the early settlers homes. Julie Ferriman was present to identify them and Duane Johnson will make up the ID tags for the pictures.

Conrad attended the Issue II meeting and reported on it. Gmandt will attend the next one.

He checked prices at BFI and Ashland recycling for selling recycled products.

Younglas reported the Chipping and Sealing has been done and all looks very good.

Gordon met with Magic Doors about installing new doors on the garage, prior to the addition, as requested by Schettler. They will cost about \$8,500.00 installed. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas they be bought and installed. Roll call, all yes.
