

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting

October 20, 2009

Tom Younglas and Richard Conrad were present for the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees which convened at 8 P.M. There were ten guests. Following the pledge the minutes of the October 6 meeting were read and approved.

Zoning Inspector Donahue gave a report on a meeting he attended. He was informed of a request for a house number for a home business. Township policy is for house numbers to be issued for a home or commercial area, not home businesses.

Younglas stated that the footers have all been put in at the cemetery. He met with Don Weiland who is restoring the cemetery stones and the job Weiland is doing is excellent. The large stones will need a tractor to straighten them up. This will be a project for spring when the ground is dry.

Conrad has been approached by a firm in Zanesville about taking the township recyclables to them. The distance is a negative factor. There was a hole in the road on Jones Road at Rte 301. He and Gordon viewed it and called ODOT to request they repair it since it takes water from Rte 301 as well as Jones Road. ODOT agreed to put in a culvert.

Jackie Johnson and Linda Van Meter have been photographing the cemetery stones. Duane Johnson will put the photos on a CD for the township.

The September financial reports were approved on a motion by Conrad, second by Younglas.

The possibility of erecting a wind turbine to assist in electric bills at the township buildings will be checked into.

With no further business, Younglas made the motion to adjourn at 8:25 P.M.
