

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting**

November 17, 2009

There were 11 guests and all the officers present at the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees. The November 3 minutes were read and approved.

Jean Eglin gave a Well Help report. Food will be collected at the Christmas Concert held in Penfield for the food baskets.

Zoning Secretary Linda Van Meter stated that a home business application will be considered for Mark Gordon for a gunsmithing shop on November 20.

Bill Albrecht has all the road sides mowed as well as the newly purchased property.

Trustee Richard Conrad said that the property is now officially the Townships that is next to the park. An environmental test must be taken before the fire department can burn it down. Lloyd Gordon said there is a man interested in tearing it down for what he can salvage from it. A test would cost about \$700.00.

Duane Johnson, reporting for the Recreation Board announced the youth football league will be using the soccer field.

The road mileage submitted by the engineers is 8.38 miles. It was approved on a motion by Tom Younglas, second by Conrad. Roll call all yes.

Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas that the annual tractor trade in be approved. A \$1,000.00 purchase order for it was also approved in the same motion. Roll call, all yes. The tires and bucket from the old tractor will be kept. Trade in of the lawn mowers was discussed with the consensus that they be kept another year.

Trustees Conrad, Younglas and Gordon, trustee elect Duane Johnson, Keith Shively, Al Bell and Bill Albrecht met at the new property and cleaned up the old fencing and other trash on the land. Gordon donated the use of his back hoe for the job. Gordon took the plow truck home and sand blasted the wheels and painted them.

The hall windows are in need of washing. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas, John McMahon be hired. Motion passed.

Conrad has taken the load of recyclables to Allied Waste. Business cards with the new officers names will be ordered.

A check to the Country House Doctor was approved on a motion by Gordon, second by Younglas, Motion carried.
