

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 1/15/08

All the officers were present for the regular meeting which convened at 8:04 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Gordon made the motion second by Younglas that Gary Weigl be re-appointed to the Board of Zoning Appeals for a five year term. Motion carried.

Albrecht stated that the pins in the cemetery are badly discolored. He suggested that a metal detector be bought to assist in locating graves.

Dan Gieb, representing South Shore Cable Company, told of updates the company will be making, Fiber optic lines, high speed internet and replacement of lines are planned. When these are done, the Cable Company will probably ask for a ten year extension on the contract.

The Sheriff's deputy handed out his report. There were 12 incidents, one of which was an assault of a family member by another member.

Temporary appropriations were approved on a motion by Gordon, second by Younglas. Roll call, all yes.

Mr. Roth was present to ask for the trustees help on a problem with the neighbors pond. He contends that when the neighbors cleaned it, they dammed it up higher and his yard has been flooding ever since. Soil and Water will be contacted for assistance and advice.

Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas that the mileage for officers traveling out of the township be reimbursed at the rate approved by the state. 48.5 cents a mile. Roll call, all yes
