All the officers and 5 guests were present for the regular meeting which convened at 8:03 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Zoning inspector Donahue handed out his written report. He has sent letters to two repeat violators giving them ten days to clean up. They did clean up some trash but the unlicensed, inoperable vehicles remain.

A fund raiser is planned for a student that has leukemia, trustees will donate the use of the hall.

The legislation involving cell towers was discussed. The prosecutor will send proposed wordage on resolutions concerning them. Dan Geib, of the Grafton Cable Company will attend the next meeting with a report.

Tom Younglas reported on the B2C2 meeting. He stated that tentatively the Penfield School will be up for sale after the first of the year.

The bills were presented and paid on a motion by Conrad, second by Younglas. Roll call, all yes.

Gordon has ordered the tractor ,salt and cinders. He and Conrad worked on repairing the cinder shed and have more work to do on it. They moved equipment and tools around in the garage for easier accessibility.
