

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 12/18/07

All the officers were present for the regular meeting which convened at 8:00 P.M. The minutes of the December 4 meeting were read and approved.

Zoning Inspector Donahue reported that he has visited one of the violators and will follow up on it. The Prosecutor will be contacted for assistance. The other has moved and left the trash which includes several sofas and miscellaneous items. Conrad will contact her and see if she will cooperate in the clean up.

The bills were presented for payment and approved on a motion by Conrad, second by Younglas. Motion carried.

Linda Albrecht has agreed to accept a 5 year term on the Zoning Commission.

The year end meeting was set for December 31 at 10 A.M.

Penfield is hosting the Lorain County Association for the December meeting. The Keystone Alumni Band and friends will perform. Younglas made the motion, second by Conrad they be given \$200.00 to cover their expenses. Roll call, all yes.

The Fiscal Officer has been informed that the grant for the parking lot expansion has been disapproved due to lack of funds from the commissioners.

Conrad reported on the Issue II meeting he attended. The representative from South Shore Cable was unable to attend tonight's meeting but promised to be at the next meeting.

Younglas stated that he had one burial, a cremation, this past week.

There was a hunter on the Gordon property that died of natural causes. Gordon praised the sheriff, coroner and fire department on the quick response and professionalism that was received.

The sheriffs deputy was present to give a report. There were 18 incidents in the township in the month of November, none of which were serious.
