

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 2/20/07

Meeting commenced at 8:05 PM with Trustees Gordon and Younglas and 6 guests present.

In the absence of the Fiscal Officer the reading of previous minutes and correspondence was dispensed with.

Trustee Younglas inquired about a potential lot split on the 31 acres on Diagonal Rd owned by the estate of Steve Bara. The zoning inspector replied that this was only an inquiry by a potential buyer, who was not a developer, and nothing appeared to be imminent.

Jean Eglin advised that the county-wide dumpster day & Pride Day has been set for May 19th and that the Keystone Alumni Band & Friends had asked for the use of the Community Room to celebrate Earth Day on April 21st. The Trustees agreed to reserve the use of the halls for those dates. She further inquired as to whether shrubs or a stand of roses could be placed in the cemetery where the large maple tree had been removed. It was agreed to pursue this.

Linda Van Meter, zoning secretary, distributed corrected minutes for the January meeting of the Zoning Commission and Board of Appeals.

Trustee Gordon advised Bill Albrecht that a new load of cinders had been ordered and he complimented Bill on the recent snowplowing activities. There was some discussion on setting a policy for replacement of mailboxes that have been damaged due to snowplowing. Trustee Gordon will consult with Assistant Prosecuting Attorney, Tom Mangan in developing a reimbursement policy. Gordon also noted that one of the sound panels in the hall had come loose and asked Bill to contact his son to reinstall it.

Trustee Younglas advised that the company responsible for maintenance of fire extinguishers has collected those that need refilling.

Trustee Gordon gave an update on the addition to the maintenance garage, the work is proceeding as scheduled, and the project is now weather tight.

Bill Albrecht inquired about the signs that were ordered for the cemetery. They have been delivered and are on the pavement next to the fuel tanks.

All present were asked to think about a speaker for the Memorial Day celebration.

Upon motion by Younglas, second by Gordon the meeting was adjourned at 8:35PM
