

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting**

April 7, 2009

All the officers were present for the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees which convened at 8 P.M. Also attending were nine guests. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Zoning Inspector Donahue gave his written report and stated Murray has cleaned up a lot, a comment that Gordon also made.

Albrecht has had the truck E checked and power washed the snow plow. He stated the new body is being damaged by the cinders and suggested only salt be used in the future for winter road maintenance. He is having trouble with the batteries on the truck and may need new ones. Polen Implement can no longer provide a mower with a 72" deck, only 60". Using the old mower deck will be checked into.

Jean Eglin reported on Pride Day plans and stated there will only be two dumpsters provided. The Salvation Army is asking to replace the "Planet Aid" clothing donation boxes with their own. No action was taken. There will be additional tire dumpsters but the location hasn't been set. Earth Day activities are planned to include a band concert by the Keystone Alumni Band and Friends.

Duane Johnson said the Recreation Board sold over 300 meals at the Palm Sunday breakfast compared with 187 last year. He asked for, and got, permission to make changes in the interior of the kitchen cupboards.

Conrad made the motion to approve the checks and purchase order. Second by Gordon. Roll call, all yes.

The Fiscal Officer was given permission to advance \$2,000 from the General Fund to the Recycling Grant and appropriate \$7,500 into intergovernmental receipts. Motion by Younglas, second by Gordon. Motion carried.

A representative from the Engineers Office rode the roads with the trustees and made suggestions. Younglas made the motion the bid books be drawn up with the bids to be opened at the May 3 meeting. Second by Gordon. Roll call, all yes.

Gordon reported getting positive comments on the news letter and good response on the reflective house numbers the Ambulance and Fire Boards are giving away.

Younglas and Conrad attended the county meeting and reported on it. Conrad stated he has still not gotten any response from Crest fence . They promise but have not done any repairs.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:50 on a motion by Younglas, second by Gordon.
