

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 5/15/07

All the officers and 8 guests were present for the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees which convened at 8:07 P.M. The minutes were read with one correction. Conrad picked up trash along Short Road, not Sooy Road.

Bill Armitage of Webster Road was present to ask about filling in his roadside ditch. The area is under LaGrange's care and he was referred to them.

Zoning Inspector Donahue reported on permits and the dumpster placement for Pride Day.

Roadman Albrecht investigated a report of a tile blow out on Foster and Jones Road. This is on private property. It is thought that either the county or rural water plugged the outlet and they will be contacted.

Ideas for improving the appearance of the cemetery were discussed, It was decided to spend \$300 for weed and feed to eliminate the weeds that are coming up.

Neil Crawford stated that roosting birds are making messes on the picnic tables. Duane Johnson from the Recreation Board said that they are considering putting material under the rafters to prevent roosting. Duane said the squares under the playground are coming up. The Fiscal Officer will check to see what can be done with Turtle Plastics who installed them.

Jean Eglin presented the plans for Pride Day. She stated that a senior citizen needs help cleaning up his property. A 4H group will be sent to do so. Another person needs help in bringing furniture to the dumpster. Trustee Gordon will do it for her.

Three bids were opened for road work. Lytle bid \$61,835.90; Cross Roads bid \$69,787.50 and Erie Blacktop bid \$70,638.20. Pending approval by the Engineers, the bid will be awarded to Lytle. Motion by Younglas, second by Conrad,. Roll call, all yes.

The bills were approved by payment as presented on a motion by Conrad, second by Younglas. Motion carried.

Gordon will talk to Crest fence because the fence still isn't right. He presented a Certificate of Appreciation to Jean Eglin, signed by the Governor, for her efforts on behalf of recycling.

With no further business, Conrad made the motion to adjourn, second by Younglas at 9:15 P.M.
