

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting**

June 2, 2009

All the officers were present as well as 12 guests for the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees which convened at 8 P.M.

Zoning Inspector Donahue reported on the meeting he attended at Blacklick and felt it was very worthwhile. He has three properties that need mowing. Other entities will be contacted to see how they are handling the matter.

Don Weiland was present to speak to the trustees about the proposed restoration of some of the cemetery stones. He will straighten, clean and repair at \$15.00 an hour plus material. He showed photos of his work. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas to hire him. Roll call, all yes.

Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas to pay the bills as presented and approve the purchase orders. Roll call, all yes.

The house next to the park on about six acres was up for sheriffs sale. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas that Gordon check into it and offer \$80,000.00. It would be an addition to the park. Motion carried.

Younglas stated that one footer was put in at the cemetery. A body is being exhumed this week.

The Fiscal Officer has dial up internet that is causing problems. Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas that the township install high speed for the Fiscal Officer and pay the fee for Internet for the Zoning Inspectors. Conrad will make the arrangements.

Gordon remarked that he has had many compliments on the condition of the cemetery. He has looked into the water drainage problem at Jones Road. It has been determined that if the ditch is cleaned for about 700' on the north side from the creek and from 1,000' to 1,500' on the south side, west of Foster Rd. it would be a big improvement in the drainage. The dirt will be given to the man wanting to install roadside tile. Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas that it be cleaned. Motion carried.

Conrad cleaned the outhouse at the small park and purchased cleaning supplies for Storms to keep it clean.

With no further business, Younglas made the motion to adjourn at 8:55 P.M.
