

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting**

June 16, 2009

Younglas and Conrad were present for the regular Penfield Township meeting. The minutes of the June 2, 2009 meeting were read and approved.

Zoning Inspector Donahue has left notices for the violators not cutting lawns. One responded, one cut a very small area and one had no response. A lawn mowing service will be contacted to get the needed work done with the cost going on the property taxes. He attended a Zoning Commission meeting in Columbus with Nort Dennison going also. He felt it is very worth while.

The May financial report was approved on a motion by Younglas, second by Conrad. A motion to remain with OTARMA as the insurance carrier for the township was made by Conrad, second by Younglas.

Representing the Recreation Board, Duane Johnson stated that a health department inspection is requiring a hand washing sink in the pavilion.

A motion was made by Younglas, second by Conrad the appropriations for gas tax be increased by \$10,000.00.

Younglas said that Lytle has begun berming and has been working on Sooy Road. It is thought that the electric poles will still have to be moved back.

Conrad told that Gordon has been trying to contact the bank regarding the property next to the park without success.

Conrad has talked to two Jones Road residents regarding water problems. This is not a township problem but one the property owners have to resolve among themselves. He informed them of the work the township will be doing in the area. Crest Fence has repaired the fence in the small park.

With no further business, Younglas made the motion to adjourn at 8:37 P.M.
