

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 6/19/07

The minutes of the June 5 meeting were read and approved with one clarification. It sounds as if Conrad met with the county on a water problem on Sooy Road when the meeting actually was on the Jones/ Foster Road area problem.

Richard Donahue checked on fire extinguishers and received permission from Gordon to purchase one. He stated that youth are using the ramp and parking lot for skateboarding. In addition, the steps are being soaped. A "no skateboarding" sign will be erected. Conrad will contact the parents of one boy who was seen skateboarding there.

Paul Eglin gave an update on his activities. A load of trash from a building was dumped in the parking lot and he cleaned it up.

Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas the bills be paid as presented. Roll call, all yes.

The trustees met with John Hamilton regarding the second phase of the Sooy Road improvement using Issue II funds.

The dumpster is still not adequate even though it is being picked up weekly. A larger dumpster will be ordered and picked up weekly.

Conrad met with the Fire Chief and was informed that the NIMS testing is not mandatory but desirable.

Bleeding on township roads brought on a complaint. LaGrange Township has agreed to coat them when and where needed.

Although there hasn't been any talk of the new trash receptacles in the Township that Solid Waste and Allied are proposing, an objection was made.

A note of thanks was received for the use of the hall for the Penfield School Alumni banquet.

Younglas reported that the piping on the southeast corner of Whitehead Road and Rte. 18 is adequate to support a fire hydrant. The cost would be \$3,000.00 Conrad urged all to attend the Commissioners meeting on the Sheriff patrol on June 28. He attended a meeting on new septic regulations and spoke on it.

The budget hearing was set for July 3 at 7:30 P.M. With no further business, the meeting adjourned on a motion by Younglas, second by Conrad.
