

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 7/17/07

Trustees Conrad and Younglas answered the roll call when the regular meeting was called to order at 8:03 P.M. Following the Pledge, the minutes of the July 3 meeting were read and approved as presented.

Richard Donahue stated that the best price for a fire extinguisher was at Fire Protection Service and was told to order one. He pointed out the need for corner protectors in the hallway and was told to buy them.

Jackie and Duane Johnson were present representing the Recreation Board. They said that the tournaments went well. The Board is considering buying a new tractor for the park under the State Purchasing Plan. The roof to the pavilion is leaking. The Park Board would like to put on a ceiling to prevent the birds from roosting. Younglas made the motion the township absorb the cost of the roof. Second by Conrad.

Tim Tyrone will repair a leaking faucet on the side of the halls and check the hot water tank which is also leaking. Motion by Younglas, second by Conrad.

It was reported that there is asphalt bleeding on Jones Road at Foster. Younglas viewed the ditch on Jones Road and doesn't think it needs cleaning. The trustees will look at it again.

There will be a zoning variance requested for a home office at the July 25 meeting of the Board of Zoning Appeals.
