

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 8/1/06**

All three trustees were present for the regular meeting. Eight guests were present. Following the pledge the meeting was called to order at 8 P.M. The minutes of the July 18 meeting were read with one correction. The roads will be chip and sealed, not resurfaced.

There are problems with the hall refrigerator. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas that Erma Donahue and Eleanor Gndt purchase a replacement. All in favor.

Richard Donahue stated that Tom Mangan received a call from the cable company regarding Penfield's service area and it will be followed up on. he has received figures on the sign for the web address. The cost will be \$267.00 Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas that it be bought. Roll call, all yes. The prosecutor has written the zoning violator.

Cleaning up of debris left from the tree cutting in the cemetery will be taken care of.

Discussion was held on repairs to the toys in the park. Neil Crawford will attend to them.

Gerald Smith asked what the townships responsibility was regarding an electric fence installed by his neighbors to contain their farm animals. It is next to his property. He says the animals are on his side of the neighbors yard, they are unsightly and there is an odor. He was informed that it is common practice to contain farm animals with an electric fence and the township has no responsibility. He asked what can be done about ATV's on his land. he will have it surveyed to make sure they are on his land. This is a common problem.

Resolution 8-1-06, supporting the sheriff patrol of townships was approved on a motion by Younglas, second by Conrad. Roll call, all yes.

Silence panels for the small hall will be ordered from Leonard Company at a cost of \$3,088.00

Younglas made the motion, second by Conrad the bills be paid as presented. Roll call, all yes.
