

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting

August 18, 2009

All the officers and nine guests were present for the regular meeting of the Penfield Township Trustees. Following the Pledge, the minutes of the July 21 and August 4 meetings were read and approved with one addition. Lloyd Gordon also donated a tank for watering flowers..

Erma Donahue has tendered her resignation as caretaker of the halls. Richard Conrad made the motion, second by Lloyd Gordon that Delores Pelerow be hired in her place @ \$10.00 hr for cleaning and \$9.50 for each hall opening. Roll call, all yes.

Richard Donahue stated that 69 residents used the dumpsters. Three trash and one metal dumpsters were filled. 25 gallons of oil were collected. Duane Johnson and Dave Thomas worked as volunteers as well as the trustees and employees.

Jones Road has been mowed and Webster and Short will be done. Bill Albrecht commented on the nice job done on the Jones Road ditch.

Duane Johnson stated the first round of work needed at the park has been completed. The Park Board will host the Jim Denes Poker Run on October 3.

Gordon made the motion, seconded by Conrad that checks #8035-#8039 be approved for payment as well as the purchase order. Roll call, all yes.

Tom Younglas reported that there was a funeral that morning.

Gordon will take the dump truck in to Gledhill. He has donated a cutting edge for the loader bucket. Chris French has approached him about several ideas he has for the Cemetery for his Eagle Scout project. He will present a completed plan to the trustees for approval. He stated that two Jones Road signs one Sooy Road sign have been stolen. Conrad said the one at Foster and Indian Hollow is also gone. It appears a chain has been hooked to them to tear them off. Gordon asked that the green reflective sign use be encouraged. The Ambulance and Fire Boards are donating them to residents of the district. Duane Johnson has donated tires for the water wagon. It has a 2" discharge and a pump vs. gravity discharge was discussed

Conrad said he took a load of recyclables in and the brakes on the recycling truck were smoking. It will be taken to M&R for needed repairs.

Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas to adjourn at 9:03 P.M.
