

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting

September 2, 2008

All the officers and nine guests were present for the regular meeting of the Penfield Trustees which convened at 8 P.M. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Zoning Inspector Donahue gave his written and oral reports. The two persons that have expiring or expired temporary living quarter permits have been contacted and given time to respond. Nothing was heard from either one. The trustees will visit them and see what their intentions are. Donahue stated that some unkept lawns have been mowed. He will write the owner of 19780 Whitehead and inform them of the steps that can be taken if they do not do the mowing.

Zoning Secretary Van Meter reported on the public hearing on the proposed zoning change. The board agreed to rezone the area including Nosters, Butchars, and the old school from residential to commercial. The trustees set their hearing on the matter for September 16 at 7:30 P.M.

The possibility of getting a dumpster on October 11 will be looked into. Janet Stoffer of the Elyria Public Library, LaGrange Branch, was present to introduce herself.

Albrecht reported on the ditching and clean up of dirt at the cemetery that has been done.

Gordon stated that the truck bed will be in shortly. Fence posts have to be replaced at both the cemetery and park and Crest will do the job. He has ordered cinders and salt.

The trustees patrolled the roads and Crossroads did a good job, but they questioned the berming that was supposed to have been done. Crossroads adjusted the bill to compensate for it.

There has been a complaint that Webster Road is not striped. Trustee Younglas spoke on the need to widen it due to the amount of traffic.

Younglas made the motion to approve the checks and purchase orders as presented. Second by Gordon. Roll call, all yes.

With no further business, Gordon made the motion to adjourn at 8:40 P.M.
