

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 9/5/06**

All the officers were present for the regular meeting. Nine guests were in attendance. Following the Pledge, the minutes of the August 15 meeting were read and approved.

Zoning Inspector Donahue stated that the township is not receiving credit for the cable subscribers on the south side of Webster Road and he is questioning if this could be happening on the north side of Smith also. The location of the proposed erection of a cell tower at the Kiser residence is under discussion with the parties involved. A building has gone up on Indian Hollow Road without a permit that is not in compliance with zoning. A variance has been applied for. He will be sending applications for home business to be reviewed by the Board of Zoning Appeals at their October meeting. He gave a report on the disastrous hall rental where a plumber had to be called and extensive cleaning done. The security deposit will be withheld.

A zoning workshop is being offered. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas that any board member or the Zoning Inspector that wishes to go have their expenses paid. Roll call, all yes.

Deputy Curtis stated that there has been nothing major happening in the township. A series of burglaries have been in the neighboring township. He warned to keep homes and out all buildings locked. There are speed complaints.

Neil Crawford asked if he and Paul Eglin could work with the Park Board backfilling around the sidewalks and was granted permission.

Eglin reported on work done at the cemetery.

Jean Eglin told those in attendance that there are many more people in need of food and said canned goods are needed all the time by Well-Help.

There are 2 UAN workshops coming up. Gordon made the motion, second by Conrad the expenses of the Fiscal Officer be paid to attend. Roll call, all yes.

Younglas made the motion, second by Conrad to pay the bills and approve P.O.'s and Blankets as presented. Roll call, all yes.

Conrad and Donahue will attend a county building code meeting.

Revisions have to be made to the "Close the Loop" and Solid Waste grants. Permission was given to Gndt to do so on a motion by Gordon, second by Conrad. Roll call, all yes.

Ed Albrecht has been hired to install the newly purchased sound panels for the small hall. Gordon conferred with the prosecutor on the reconstruction of the garage and was informed that it was under the maximum required for bidding. He will contact the Amish

about finalizing plans and made a motion to that effect. Second by Conrad, Roll call, all yes. Gordon has been doing maintenance on the township truck.

With no further business, Younglas made the motion to adjourn at 9:17 P.M.
