

## **Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees Meeting**

September 15, 2009

Richard Conrad and Lloyd Gordon were in attendance for the regular Penfield Township Trustees meeting. Eight guests were present. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as presented.

Deputy Regendz attended to ask the trustees to approve a resolution in support of the . 5% sales tax increase on the November ballot. It will be used solely for the justice system. Passage of the tax would restore the sheriff's department to the 2006 level with the sub station open again. Conrad made the motion, second by Gordon Resolution 9-15-09 be approved supporting the levy. Motion carried.

In keeping with the surrounding communities, trick or treat was set in the township for October 31 from 6-7:30 P.M. Motion by Conrad, second by Gordon.

Zoning Inspector Richard Donahue announced a zoning seminar set for November 21 in Westlake. Cost is \$85.00 per person. Gordon made the motion second by Conrad that any member of the Zoning Commission or Board of Appeals that wants to attend have their expenses paid. Roll call, all yes.

Duane Johnson, representing the Recreation Board stated that the rest rooms and hall in the concession stand have been painted. The Board would like to remove the plastic tile that is under the playground equipment because it has deteriorated. The trustees approved the project. He was given permission to use township fuel for work in the ball fields.

Jean Eglin stated that Neil and Pat McLoda have donated flowers for around the sandstone wheel at the hall.

There is a water leak in the small park. The Country House Doctor will be contacted to repair it.

Conrad made the motion the bills be paid as presented. Gordon seconded the motion. Roll call, all yes.

Gordon reported that the South Lorain County Ambulance District has agreed to donate \$1,000.00 to each of the two defibrillators.

Conrad stated that Bob Storms will be on vacation in December and January, Delores Telzerow will fill in on Saturdays at the Recycling Building and Richard Donahue handle it in Wednesday.

At 8:50 Conrad made the motion the meeting adjourn, second by Gordon.
