

Minutes of Penfield Township Board of Trustees meeting held 9/19/06

All the officers were present for the regular Penfield Township trustees meeting. After the Pledge, the minutes of the September 5 meeting were approved with one addition. Resolution 9-5-06, a resolution applying for a \$38,110.00 Issue II grant, was approved on a motion by Gordon, second by Conrad. Roll call, all yes.

Richard Donahue stated that there is another load of recyclables to be taken in. Conrad will do so. He has not heard any further from the cable company on the questionable addresses for rebate credit. He has mailed out applications for home businesses and reminded that these must be obtained.

Jean Eglin was given permission to purchase flowers where needed on the township grounds.

Paul Eglin reported on work at the park and cemetery. He would like to install lights on the trailer and was told to do so.

Jackie Johnson said that the Recreation Board will have a Halloween party for Penfield Township children on October 29 from 3:30-5 P.M. with costume and carved pumpkin judging at 4:30. Hot dogs and snacks will be served.

Duane Johnson gave an update on Recreation Board activities, including the planting of perennials.

Sue Moreno, candidate for 13th District in the State Senate, spoke on her credentials for the position.

Conrad delivered a load of recyclables last week. He met with Mitch Cloudt on seeding the cemetery and township buildings. Cloudt will apply broadleaf killer and fertilize a needed area in the cemetery for \$435.00 and where needed, seed and fertilize at the hall for \$611.00. Conrad also met with Crest fence regarding fence posts that are heaved up in the cemetery and park. Township employees will remove the posts. Crest will drill holes toward the bottom, fill them with concrete and reinstall for \$2,558.00 at the park and \$2,926.00 at the cemetery. Gordon made the motion, second by Younglas both contracts be awarded. Motion carried.

Gordon reported on the progress of the drainage into the park. He said John McMahon will wash the outside windows and screens at the halls for \$125.00. Younglas made the motion, second by Conrad, he be hired to do so. Roll call, all yes.

The trustees met with Levi Schettler on drawing up plans for the garage addition. Conrad made the motion, second by Younglas, he be hired to proceed with the plans, addition and labor. Roll call, all yes.

Trees have been planted on township property in memory of Jim and Chris Denes by Mrs. Jackson.

With no further business, Conrad made the motion, second by Youglas to adjourn.
